# Gradual build-up of tension

# Backfill

WHO: A child and their grandfather.

WHAT: Cicada-watching. WHERE: Apex Reserve. WHFN: Summer.

# **Pebble** (Small problem)

This year the child wants to see a Black Prince cicada. the rarest type of all! They start by searching for nymphs in the wavy grass.

# Rock (Medium problem)

Torches on – the scene is set to see a nymph climb up the tree trunk, ready to split its shell and change into an adult.

## **Boulder**

(Main tension scene)

It's hard to sleep! The child can't wait till morning to find cicadas, particularly the elusive Black Prince.
