Top Tips for Teacher Hub

1. **Start with the Writing Courses** – Each course walks you through how to Learn, Teach, Apply and Assess the Seven Steps in a particular text type (<u>Informative</u>, <u>Narrative</u> and <u>Persuasive</u>). With over 150 hand-picked resources in each course, they have everything you need to roll out the Seven Steps in your classroom. To find out more watch this video:



2. **The filters are your friend** – When you are searching for a resource in the Resource Library start by using the filters. Select the Text Type and the Step you are working on to filter the resources. If you need to refine your search further there are also filters for Purpose (Learn, Teach, Apply, Assess), Year Level and Resource Type. To find out more watch this video:



- 3. **Limit your search terms** If you are using the key word search, search for a single term rather than multiple terms, e.g. 'graph' will bring up all the story graphs and writing graphs. If you specifically want the narrative story graph, then select 'Narrative' in the dropdown and type 'graph' in the key word search.
- 4. **Favourite the resources you love** When you find a resource you love, click on the star in the right-hand corner of the resource tile or page. This will add it to your favourites which can be accessed by clicking on 'Show favourites' in the Resource Library.
- 5. **Use the classroom planner** If you know when you want to use a particular resource add it to your classroom planner by clicking on 'Add to Planner' on the resource tile or page. To find out more view this video:
