Learning Intentions could include:

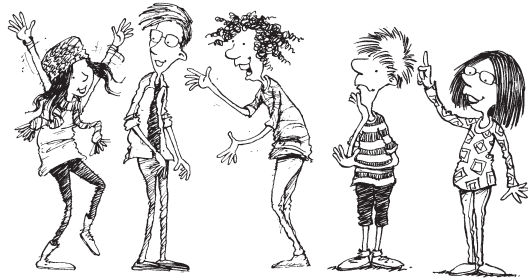
- Be able to use all of the Seven Steps to create a complete piece of writing.
